

EAGLE LAKE IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT 2023 ANNUAL REPORT

Introduction:

Minnesota Statutes section 103B.571(4) requires Lake Improvement Districts to file an Annual Report to the County Board of Commissioners, Eagle Lake Township Board, the Commissioner of Natural Resources, and the Minnesota Pollution Control Agency.

The functions of the Eagle Lake Improvement District (ELID) are overseen by the seven-member board of directors. The initial directors were appointed by the Otter Tail County Commissioners to alternating terms of one (2 directors), two (3 directors), and three-year (2 directors) terms. Beginning in 2022 the expiring terms of two directors were elected by property owners to a three-year term. Following is a list of the directors for 2023 and the year in which their term expires.

Current Year 2023:

- The 2nd Annual Meeting of the Eagle Lake Improvement District occurred on July 8, 2023.
- The Membership approved a \$50 fee per each ELID riparian parcel for operating expenses and to fund a future replacement of the existing aging outlet culvert.
- The culvert replacement project was approved at the 2022 Annual Meeting and will be completed when construction funds are available.

Future Projects Being Considered:

- Establish a monitoring program for aquatic invasive species.
- Establish a targeted water quality monitoring program.
- Identify and begin a water quality monitoring program of ponds that seasonally overflow into Eagle Lake.
- Cleaning concrete section of culvert outlet of zebra mussels.
